


# International Foundation Year

# What is the International Foundation Year?

Our International Foundation Year gives you access to year one of a UK degree. As part of the IFY programme you will complete 4 modules. These are:

BUSINESS	MATHEMATICS
ACADEMIC ENGLISH	ECONOMICS

The programme is one year in duration and assessments are conducted through written examinations and continuous coursework. As well as equipping you with the English skills and academic qualifications for studying in the UK, the IFY increases your cultural awareness and develops your skills which enable you to study in a western environment.

#### What are the entry requirements?


Generally, you must be 17 years of age, have completed 12 years of education and have an IELTS 5.0 or equivalent English language test. For country specific requirements, please see our website.

#### What about help with English Language Skills?

All our programmes feature specially designed English for Academic Purposes (EAP) modules. These are aimed at giving you the specific language and study skills that you need to succeed in your studies, meaning that you are ready to start learning as soon as you arrive at your UK university. EAP is recognised for visa purposes by 16 famous British Universities so there is no need for the expense of an IELTS test. The EAP part of our programme is delivered by our partner Foyle International who have over 27 years' experience in delivering a range of English language examination courses.

## What options are available to me after my IFY programme?

#### Can I choose which university I want to go to?

The better you do the more choice you will have.

#### **Facilities at the College**

#### Where will you stay?

Accommodation will be provided by Foyle International. It is recommended initially that you stay with a home stay provider in the local area. This family will help you to adapt to the local culture and life in the city.



When the student feels more confident they will be given the option to continue living with the family or to move to a more independent accommodation facility in the local University student campus. Both these types of accommodation will be close to the college.
